TRADITIONAL

Karuizawa began its growth as a summer retreat in 1886 when foreign missionaries visited the area to escape the heat, and is now known nationwide as one of Japan's leading highlands resort areas.

INTERNATIONAL

Karuizawa is the only place in Japan to have hosted both summer and winter Olympic competition (equestrian eventing at the 1964 Tokyo Olympic Games and curling at the 1998 Nagano Olympic Winter Games). The town's international character is the result of deep historical ties with people from overseas.

ELEGANT

Karuizawa carefully protects its bountiful nature, tranquil environment, and wonderful scenery. Some of Japan's leading music halls and museums, as well as numerous churches and chapels, stand quietly amid the town's beautiful natural surroundings.
