UWC ISAK Japan invites local families to be matched with our international students in order to provide informal social and cultural exchange opportunities. This is not a homestay program, but rather a chance to connect UWC ISAK Japan students with the local community. Friendship Families will meet their student for lunch/or dinner in the home or elsewhere, museum visits, cooking exchanges, sporting events, game nights, and/or good conversation. There will also be organized events at UWC ISAK Japan at the beginning and end of the academic year to facilitate contact. It is the goal of this program to build a relationship that will bring greater understanding and enrichment for both sides.

EXPECTATIONS

- Keep an open mind. Your friendship will be with a student with various cultural values, religious practices, and or unique backgrounds from your own.
- Ensure you follow safeguarding and child protection guidelines. We will provide training.
- Attend events on campus for Friendship Families (two per year).
- Meet your student for outings or planned activities once a month. You may either provide transportation from campus to the activity, or the student may prefer to meet you at a predetermined location.
- Stay involved for one academic year (September 2024 May 2025).
